

## ONC HIT Certification Program Transparency Attestation Requirement: 45 CFR § 170.523(k)(2)

The 2015 Edition Final Rule includes a new transparency attestation requirement that is applicable to all health IT developers whose product(s) have been issued a 2014 Edition or later certification. A developer only needs to respond to the attestation once, even if it has multiple product certifications. All health IT developers <u>must</u> make one of the following attestations:

Please take note that a developer's attestation under 45 CFR § 170.523(k)(2) does not broaden or change the scope of the information a developer is required to disclose under 45 CFR § 170.523(k)(1).
